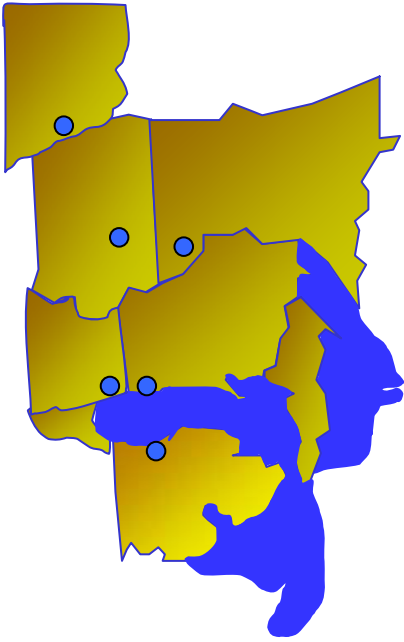

(tax free, no permit required)

Ethanol Recovery & Reprocessing

Brenntag Great Lakes is a licensed TSD (transporter, storage, & disposal) facility for spent solvents. Waste ethanol can be reprocessed through distillation and dehydration for use in industrial ethanol applications. Fermentation ethanol can be reprocessed for use in the fuel market.
